Schedule

Commit to volunteer at least one day per week (Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday) for at least 1 hour (between 4:10pm and 6:40pm during the school year or 10:30am and 3:30pm during the summer). Consistency is important, so while perfect attendance is not expected, we need people who can be present more often than not.

Volunteer Responsibilities

During the school year:

- From 4:10pm to 4:40pm, volunteers may help monitor recess and join in with the kids' games.
- Between 4:45pm and 6:00pm, volunteers may provide homework help or individual tutoring in reading, writing, or math.
- From 6:05pm to 6:40pm, volunteers may help serve meals.

During the summer:

- From 10:30am to 11:30am, volunteers may help monitor recess and join in with the kids' games.
- From 11:30am to 12:00pm, volunteers may help serve meals
- From 12:00pm to 3:30pm, volunteers may provide individual tutoring or serve as field trip chaperones.

Volunteers may also have the opportunity to arrange special activities or serve as a guest instructor in an area of interest or expertise..
